Local systems are set up to drive and sustain reductions


Proven technical strategies implemented Federal structural reform creates the superconditions to end homelessness

### We need to Change the system to solve the problem

#### **The Problem**



No single actor is fully accountable for ending homelessness in a community.

#### The Built for Zero Solution



An integrated, coordinated team.



Funders evaluate success on the performance of individual housing programs.



Community-level measurements look at performance of the system toward an end to homelessness.



A once-a-year count of a problem that changes nightly.



Comprehensive real-time, by name data.



Housing supply paralysis.



Strategic, data-driven housing investments.
