83.4% of Clifford residents *rarely* shop in Clifford
38.5% of Palmerston residents *rarely* shop in Palmerston
24.3% of Harriston residents *rarely* shop in Harriston

#### **Business Retention & Expansion Survey**

Downtown Revitalization identified as a priority

75%

of those surveyed wanted money invested in the Downtowns.

# Rural Economic Development (RED) Funding

The Town of Minto was successful in receiving RED Funding through the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA)

Downtown initiatives totaled nearly \$140,000 in funding over the past two years, with 1/3 from RED funding + another \$47,000 in contributions from Minto Businesses and community groups.


